

2022 SA ELECTION LGBTIQ+ POLICY SCORECARD

Last year we surveyed over 600 LGBTIQ+ South Australians and their allies in partnership with Equality Australia to create our communities Vision for SA Pride.

This year in the lead up to the 2022 SA Election, we wrote to political parties asking them to commit to our Vision and reinstate the Pride of South Australia.

This scorecard is our independent assessment of parties' policies developed to inform our communities about where parties stand on LGBTIQ+ health, safety and inclusion.
